This innovative processing ensures that recycled plastic can be used to create new, valuable products. CirPlas prioritizes a closed-loop system, returning processed plastic resin to its enabling businesses to incorporate recycled materials into their products promoting sustainability throughout their supply chain.

CirPlas' debut product, R-POT, is made from upcycled post-consumer recycled plastic sourced from "longan baskets." Typically, these baskets are reinforced with additives like talcum and calcium for durability, making them less suitable for recycling. However, CirPlas has repurposed these materials into R-POT, contributing significantly to plastic waste reduction.

Individuals can also play an active role in responsible waste management through the Zero Waste Hero Program. With convenient drop-off locations across Bangkok and weekly waste pick-up services, waste disposal becomes effortless. Monthly Plastic Collection Reports provide transparency, allowing individuals to track their impact on reducing plastic pollution.
